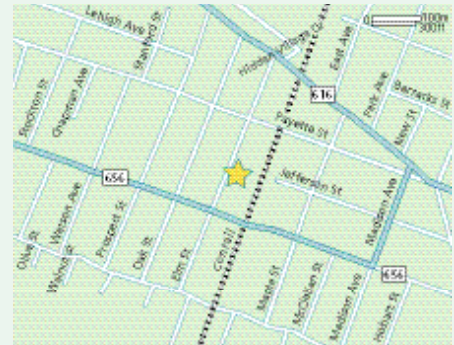

Directions

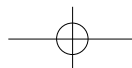
Parkway N: to exit 125. Bear right to Rte 35 N. Cross Victory Bridge. Right on Smith St. Go four lights and one block. Left onto Elm St. Alameda on left.

Parkway S: to exit 129. Follow signs to Rte 9 S./The Amboys. Take Amboy/Smith St. exit, just before Raritan Bridge. Go four lights and one block. Left onto Elm St. Alameda on left.

Turnpike N: to exit 10. Follow signs to Route 440/Smith St. exit. Take Smith St. and cross Rte 35 and Convery Blvd. After two lights and one block, turn left on Elm St. Alameda on left.

Turnpike S: to exit 11. Follow signs to Perth Amboy/Smith St exit. Take Smith St. and cross Rte 35 and Convery Blvd. After two lights and one block, turn left on Elm St. Alameda on left.

Brooklyn/Staten Island: Verrazano Bridge to Staten Island Expressway. Take W. Shore Expressway (440) to Outerbridge Crossing. Exit to Amboy Ave. Rt. on Elm Street. Alameda on right corner of Smith and Elm.
